Team-Teach Positive Behaviour Management - Level 1 (certification last for 36 months)

This course is for staff working in low risk settings such as mainstream primary and secondary schools, where physical interventions are not normally required. It covers de-escalation and basic positive handling strategies for dealing with challenging behaviour. We will also look to understand the drivers behind aggressive and disruptive behaviour and the legal context around behaviour management.

Health and Safety legislation requires employers to provide relevant training to reduce risk wherever it is foreseeable. Team Teach training is designed to help employers who have a duty of care to fulfil that duty.
